Dear Max,

The Mini-Max II I purchased from you is working great. We tear down and clean our aircraft wheels and the Mini-Max sure makes short work of our bolts. The bolts must be cleaned for magnetic particle inspection and the job used to be a long and arduous task.

The bolts holding together the wheel halves are cadmium plated. We'd have to meticulously clean the bolts without removing the plating and using any wire brush would do just that. We'd put them in an ultrasonic cleaner for several hours at a time. Once we had the bolts cleaned, we'd still get less than optimal results during NDT. Then we'd have to go back and clean them again especially under the heads and the threads.

Now, we start the cleaning process with our parts cleaner and a brush to remove the heavy stuff if necessary. Then we blast them with the Mini-Max and the bolts become so clean and dry we can go right to our NDT with great results! Not once did we have to reclean the bolts. All in all, we can now disassemble a wheel, clean the bolts, and perform our NDT during the course of one shift to maintain the bolts in a near new condition. Of course, there are other nooks and crannies on the wheels where the Mini-Max comes in handy too.
